Dear Parents

Following on from last year's extremely successful Holiday Club's we are delighted to be able to offer the Holiday Club to our pupils once again this year. The dates for this academic year are:-



**October Half-Term** - Monday 17<sup>th</sup> October - Friday 21<sup>st</sup> October 2016

**Christmas** - Monday 19<sup>th</sup> December - Friday 23<sup>rd</sup> December 2016

**Easter** – Monday 3<sup>rd</sup> April – Friday 7<sup>th</sup> April 2017

**Summer** – Wednesday 5<sup>th</sup> July – Friday 4<sup>th</sup> August 2017



The Holiday club successfully provides both boys and girls, from Reception to Year 6 (Kindergarten in the Summer term), with a wide selection of stimulating and fun age appropriate activities, utilising the substantial facilities within Reigate St Mary's. Each day the children participate in a range of stimulating and enjoyable activities from Outdoor Pursuits, Sport, Cookery, Art and Craft, Computing, Robotics and iPads to Drama.



The general format will remain the same whilst incorporating new ideas, activities, resources and locations. Separate programmes run simultaneously for pupils within both the Upper and Lower school, with 'play' times where the different ages of children can happily mix and enjoy each others company. The fundamental aim of each day will always remain;

*'To ensure that the children have fun, participating in a variety of structured activities in a safe and caring environment, playing with existing friends and developing new friendships too'.*



The holiday club day will run between 8:00 - 17:30 each day. If you would like to drop your child off at 9:00 and collect them at 16:00 that is obviously absolutely fine and we can happily accommodate it. The daily charge is £35 for the 9.5 hours of entertainment and fun.

The children will need to wear comfortable clothing, (suitable for being active) and bring a coat. You will be notified if any other specific clothing is required before the beginning of the week. Children will need to bring a snack and a packed lunch with a drink; the usual school rules apply, so no nuts, glass or fizzy drinks please. A first aider will be on site but please ensure that any emergency medication is clearly named and it is in your child's possession. The children will not be required to bring any money.
